- Finish CV and have it reviewed
- Start drafting personal statement

August

- Finish personal statement and have it reviewed
- Start compiling program application list

September

- ERAS applications open
- Interview Prep
 - Residency Prep Course & Mock Interviews

January

- Prepare and submit rank list

March

- Match Week
