Purpose

To ensure that University of Arkansas for Medical Sciences College of Medicine (UAMS COM) Accreditation Council for Graduate Medical Education (ACGME)-accredited programs provide a professional, respectful and civil environment that is free from unprofessional behavior.

Policy

The Graduate Medical Education Committee (GMEC) has adopted the following UAMS Administrative policies to address appropriate treatment of residents:

- 1) UAMS Administrative Guide, Policy 3.1.48 Title IX, Sex Discrimination, Sexual Harassment, Sexual Assault, Sexual Misconduct, Sexual Violence, Stalking, Gender-Based Harassment and Retaliation
- 2) UAMS Administrative Guide, Policy 3.1.10 Anti-Discrimination

Incidents related to Graduate Medical Education (GME) that are covered under UAMS Administrative or Institutional Policies must be reported to the Associate Dean for GME.
