Purpose: To define supplemental clinical activity and the process to request participation in such clinical activity.

Policy: The COM Internal Medicine program policy defines supplemental clinical activity including the list of rotations where supplemental clinical activities will be or will not be allowed. This policy outlines how the program will monitor supplemental clinical activity to ensure that ACGME requirements are met. This policy discusses consequences if College of Medicine (COM) Graduate Medical Education Committee (GMEC) and program policies for supplemental clinical activities are not met. This policy outlines the approval process for supplemental clinical activity. This policy follows COM GMEC policy 3.310.
