<p>The UAMS Department of Psychiatry Doctoral Internship Training Program in Clinical Psychology is accredited by the American Psychological Association (APA) and offers training through Child (Program Code # 110611); Trauma, Recovery, and Justice (Program Code # 110612); Neuropsychology (Program Code # 110613); and Integrated Health Care (Program Code # 110614) training tracks.</p>
<p>Our 2080-hour clinical psychology doctoral internship is designed to provide interns with a broad and general training experience in basic principles and techniques of professional psychology. Interns work with caring and conscientious supervisors who carefully consider the intern's training experiences, career goals, strengths, and needs in order to develop the most appropriate and effective training experience. The internship training year is July 1 through June 30 of each year.</p>
<p>The internship is one of the training programs of the Department of Psychiatry in the UAMS College of Medicine and has multiple training sites depending on the specific training track.</p>
