



Recent Grants & Research




UAMS and its affiliate research institutions saw research funding grow by 12.2% this past year, with \$177.4 million in grants by the end of the fiscal year on June 30. It is the second consecutive year with double-digit increases in research funding that comes from outside the institution.

ACRI and UAMS have received \$7.2 million in funding over five years from NIH to continue their participation in the nationwide HEALthy Brain and Child Development (HBCD) Study. Lead Arkansas investigators are Xiawei Ou, Ph.D., Ashley Acheson, Ph.D., and Lorraine McKelvey, Ph.D.
