

## UAMS Emergency Medicine Excellence Showcased at SAEM

The expertise and scholarly work of **Emergency Medicine** faculty and residents was showcased at the Society for Academic Emergency Medicine – the largest and most prestigious academic conference in the field – in New Orleans last week.
