All UAMS and UAMS Baptist-Health residents and fellows who supervise or assess medical students in the UAMS COM clerkships will complete a mandatory “Preparation to Teach” module developed jointly by the UME curriculum office and the GME office. Completion of this module will be centrally monitored by the GME, Regional Programs, and Baptist-Health offices, and the data will be shared with the UME program.

All non-UAMS trained residents and fellows who supervise or assess medical students in the UAMS COM clerkships receive the training to teach curriculum provided by their residency program, as verified by the UAMS GME program.

Non-faculty instructors, including residents, in the preclinical courses must complete an attestation that they have received the learning objectives and methods of assessment for the sessions they will be involved in teaching. Completion is tracked by the UME program.
