Family Medicine

UAMS

- Workrooms on F6, F7, and H8
- Internal Medicine/Ebert Library can additionally be used for study (Shorey S3-07)

VA

- Workrooms on 4B, 6B, and 6D for study or relaxation

VA of the Ozarks

- Room 21-2234 for Internal Medicine students and residents

Obstetrics/Gynecology

UAMS

- Large resident/student workroom on Labor and Delivery that is an excellent study space
- Break room on Labor and Delivery that students have badge access to (microwaves, refrigerators, TV)

Midtown Clinic

- Breakroom on ground floor with TV and plenty of space for eating, microwaves, refrigerators – often quiet
- Conference room near the breakroom that is rarely used and quiet

Cancer Institute

- First floor café with Starbucks and booth seating
- Work room in the clinic with computer and chair for student
- 5th floor conference room in the GynOnc Cancer office suite

Northwest Medical Center – Bentonville

Doctor's lounge is available for study or relaxation and off of it there is a charting room with computers and separated desks that is also good for studying. Students must be badged in by faculty;

Pediatrics

ACH Little Rock

- Student lounge/space on the first floor of the main hospital, adjacent to the resident lounge

ACH Northwest

- Breakrooms on each floor
- Public space in the ground level café
- Workstations between each hall

Psychiatry

UAMS

- Shared student/resident workrooms on each floor/service
- Open spaces in PRI lobby with seating open to everyone
- PRI library and conference room that can be used by students when available

VA Little Rock

- Shared student/resident work room

Arkansas State Hospital

- Student workroom called the "bullpen" on Unit A. Students have their own computers and a large conference table and can freely lounge and study in this space. Microwave and refrigerator are available.

Baptist North Little Rock

- Hospital building: workspaces with computers for medical students/residents
- GME building: access to Resident Lounge, Resident Computer Lab, two meeting rooms for didactics

- Workroom 3E
- Student lounge/space on the first floor of the main hospital, adjacent to the resident lounge

VA

- 2nd floor call rooms/lounge (includes couch)
- Workrooms on the 5th and 6th floors

Washington Regional Medical Center

- Breakroom in the clinic at 3E Appleby
- Relaxation room next to the doctor's lounge in the hospital

Geriatrics (M4)

Reynolds Institute on Aging

- Thomas and Lyon Longevity Clinic: workrooms with computers (2260K and 2260C); microwave. Includes student areas/cubicles with computers and closets
- First floor lobby: lounge chairs and tables
- First floor conference room and virtual reality room can be used when available

- Conference room on 2nd floor

North Little Rock VA third floor

- Room 3B-156-b
- Conference room (3B-172)
- Space in GEM unit office (3C-108)

Butterfield Trail Village

- Resident office with one open spot with computer access for a student
- Cafeteria

VA of the Ozarks

- Medical student workroom/conference room in Building 21 (outpatient clinics) with desktop workstations (2234)

Sunbridge VA Clinic

- Computer access at a second desk in Dr. Campbell's office
- Break room with refrigerator

Washington Regional Memory Disorders Clinic

- Work room with desk available with computer access on the Memory Disorder side of the clinic (Dr. Gemmel's side)
- Breakroom on the health clinic side in Dr. Shinn's area

Washington Regional Medical Center Hospice (lower level)

- Small conference room
- Students can sit in a bull pen area with nurses if spot available.
- Students can use their computers in any open area
- Employee lounge in building 21; includes refrigerators and microwaves, tables (2232)

Northwest clinical sites by location (not service-specific):

Relaxation:

- Quiet rooms on all seven floors
- Prayer garden
- Chapel
- Atrium
- Outdoor reflection area

Study:

- Students have access to the Resident Work Room and Conference area. If students need a board room with wifi and audio/visual capability at any time, a room can be reserved for certain days.
