Family Medicine - Main Campus and Associated Sites

Clinical site	Study space/space to read about patients	Secure storage
Baptist North Little Rock - outpatient	Computers in each of the two physician/resident workrooms where the students may review their patients and refer to appropriate electronic media for guidance. Also provide a copy of two shelf-prep books that the students may keep with them during the rotation and return at the end of the rotation. There are also quiet areas with computers in the GME/clinic building and, in our clinic, where students may sit if they prefer to be outside of the workrooms (precepting "pods").	Lockers in the breakrooms; students must bring their own locks. Resident work pods, which are not locked but have not been an issue.
UAMS Family Med Clinic - Outpatient	Students have badge access to resident lounge and two conference rooms on the 2nd floor of the clinic, away from patients.	Students can secure belongings in resident workroom, accessible only with pin code; lockers are available for students.
UAMS TOSH	Students at TOSH utilize available workstations for study and patient review.	Students can place belongings at their workstations, accessible only to clinic staff
Jefferson Regional Med Center	Students can study in the residency lounge location on the 2nd floor of the JRMC.	In the ED, students have a designated work desk and store their belongings there. In the hospital, the residency lounge on 2nd floor, accessible only with a JRMC badge, has a countertop desk, which students can store belongings underneath.
Baptist Health Lonoke Rural	There are desks in the resident workroom where students can study.	Resident workroom with lockers; students must provide their own lock.
UAMS Batesville - Outpatient	Resident workroom away from patients for students to use for study	Resident workroom with badge access in the Education Building where students may store

		belongings during clinic hours.
UAMS Jonesboro - Outpatient	Students rotating on outpatient have access to the library in the clinic with a separate room inside containing a private cubicle. Resident lounge for students who are working in the hospital.	Lockers located in the clinic area near the pods that students can use.
UAMS Pine Bluff - Outpatient	Study space is available in the pods where the residents and students sit. We have several desks with computers that students and residents use to complete assignments or to read patients' charts.	Students store belongings at the desk in the pods only accessible to clinic staff
UAMS Texarkana - Outpatient	Study space in the classroom, which can be used after hours. Other study areas include the library at local university.	Students can secure belongings in the lockers provided (in the back where faculty and admin offices are) but must provide their own lock.
UAMS Ft. Smith - Outpatient	Students have access to a designated student office where they may use to participate in their Mon/Fri virtual didactic sessions, complete assignments, or study. The office is located on the second floor of the UAMS Administration Building and is equipped with two computers for student use. Printing is also available as needed; the second-floor printer is located in the GME Coordinator's office.	Lockers are available for students to secure their belongings in both the clinic and the Student Office (2nd floor of the Admin Building). Students must bring their own lock.
UAMS Crossett - Outpatient	Students have access to the clinic conference room, which is always available except during noon didactics. We also have a resident room that is available for them if they prefer.	Students have access to the conference room, which is inaccessible to patients. The room is safe for them to leave their things and a perfect spot to study. We also have a resident room that is available for them if they prefer.

UAMS Inpatient	Workrooms on F6, F7, and H8. Internal Medicine/Ebert Library (Shorey S3-07)	Medical student workroom: keypad entry with locker availability. All students also have access to resident/team workrooms assigned for each patient service; these are badge or keypad entry.
UAMS Outpatient	MD work rooms behind the clinic space. Plenty of computers, desks, and space to read, study, access the EMR, and discuss patient care in a confidential HIPAA complaint space.	All clinics have locked doors for the students to keep their possessions secure.
VA Little Rock - Inpatient	Workrooms on 4B, 6B, and 6D	All rooms are badge or keypad entry only and automatically lock after door closure.

Midtown Clinic - Outpatient	Conference room near the breakroom that is rarely used and quiet. Breakroom on ground floor– often quiet.	Physician workrooms in each "Pod" that are accessible to MDs and students only; students can store their belongings there during clinic hours
Cancer Institute - Outpatient	Work room in the clinic with computer and chair for students. 5th floor conference room in the GynOnc Cancer office suite.	Physician workrooms are accessible to MDs and students only; students can store their belongings there during clinic hours

UAMS - Nursery	Workstations are available to study and/or read about patients.	Access to multiple workrooms with keycard access to store belongings.
ACH Little Rock - Inpatient	Student space on the first floor of the main hospital, adjacent to the resident lounge.	Medical student workroom has locker availability; room itself is locked with keypad entry. Students also have access to the resident workroom and attending call areas, which also have locker availability with locked keypad entry.
ACH Little Rock - Outpatient	Doctor workroom with additional workstations.	Doctor workrooms with locking doors can be used to keep student possessions secure.

VA Little Rock - Inpatient	Shared student/resident workroom.	Access to resident workroom, which has badge/key access.
Arkansas State Hospital - Inpatient	Student workroom called the "bullpen" on Unit A. Students have their own computers and a large conference table.	Access to resident workroom, which has badge/key access.
VA North Little Rock - Inpatient	Student workroom adjacent to the 1H inpatient unit. Availability of two other resident workrooms when there are higher number of students.	Access to resident workroom, which has badge/key access.
Baptist North Little Rock - Inpatient	Hospital building; workspaces with computers for medical students/residents. GME Building: access to resident lounge, resident computer lab, two meeting rooms.	Students have access to the workroom and lockers (need to bring their own locks).
Centers for Youth and Families - Outpatient	Shared workroom with staff.	Keyed room where students can keep belongings. Can also keep things in the shared workroom with staff.
